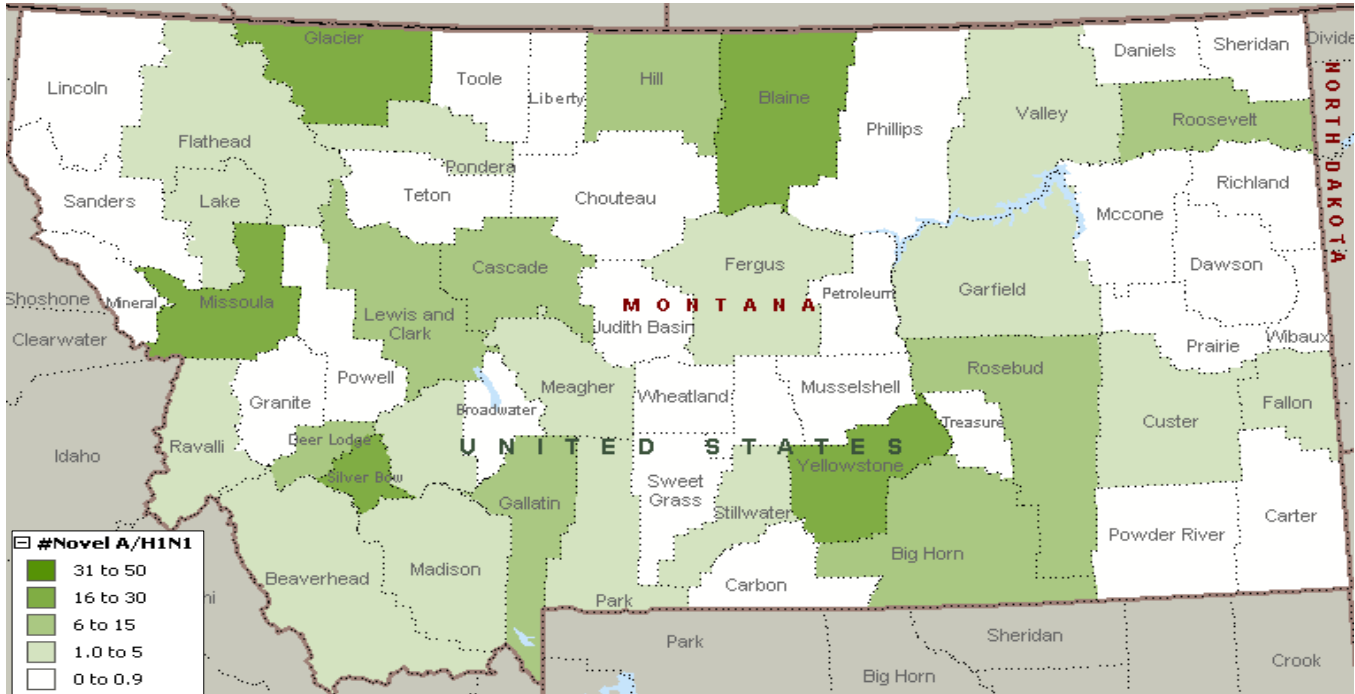


**Special Influenza Update**  
**Confirmed Novel Influenza A/H1N1 (Swine)**  
**from 04/25/2009 to 08/28/2009**

NOTE: July 24, 2009 was the last date that the CDC and Montana provided information on individual confirmed and probable cases of novel H1N1 influenza. Montana will continue to use standard surveillance systems to track the progress of the novel H1N1 influenza outbreak in the same way influenza activity is monitored for other influenza viruses at <http://cdepi.hhs.mt.gov>.

As of August 28th, confirmed cases of influenza illness with the novel Influenza A H1N1 strain had been identified in 28 counties. Twelve of these cases resulted in hospitalization. One death had been reported. Eight additional cases had been identified in visitors from other states.
