




Portrait of an MVR Counselor

- Average daily caseload – 117 active cases
- Average time in VR
 - All closed cases – 1.4 years
 - Rehabilitated cases – 2.2 years
- Individuals served per year – 204
- Consumers assisted into employment yearly – 23
- Self employment – 6.4% of total outcomes



Portrait of an MVR Counselor (cont.)



- Most Counselors work in a major Montana community and have a travel area as well.
- Each Counselor has:
 - An individual budget
 - A computer with full access to state network
 - Internet access
 - Administrative support
- Qualified Rehabilitation Counselors – 95%
(Qualified means CRC or under a plan working towards CRC)
