GENERAL RULE-- Child and Family Services Division (CFSD) will provide special funding for residential chemical dependency treatment for a child who:

1. Meets certain Medicaid requirements; and
2. Is determined to be a youth in need (as determined by CFSD) of such treatment.

PROCEDURE

Social Worker

1. Assist the parent/guardian in the completion of the application HCS-250 and necessary forms.

Eligibility Case Mgr

2. Consider the entire Family Medicaid standard filing unit (see FMA 201-1); and
 - a. Require verification of income and resources;
 - b. Determine non-financial eligibility; and
 - c. Notify social/placing worker of income and resource determination.

Social Worker

3. Evaluate countable income and determine if the 200% poverty criteria is met.

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
