If you notice these warning signs, call **9-1-1** immediately.

- ▶ Numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body.
- ▶ Loss of vision, speech or understanding.
- ▶ Trouble walking or dizziness.
- ▶ Sudden severe headache or confusion.
