

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Pursuant to House Bill 213 of the 61st legislature establishing a Southwestern Montana state veterans' home, the Architecture & Engineering Division is soliciting proposals from communities interested in becoming the site for the new state veteran's home. The Governor-appointed site selection committee has developed site-selection criteria for a facility to be located in one of the following counties: Beaverhead, Deer Lodge, Jefferson, Madison, Powell or Silver Bow.

Funding for the new home will be contingent on VA federal grant and state matching funds that will require future appropriation by the legislature.

Proposals for sites to be considered for a ***SOUTHWESTERN MONTANA STATE VETERANS' HOME, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, A/E #2010-40-01, must be received by 2 p.m. on February 5, 2010,*** in the offices of the Architecture & Engineering Division, 1520 East Sixth Avenue, Rm. 33, or P.O. Box 200103, Helena MT 59620-0103.
