Administration for Children and Families Strategic Goal 1: Increase economic independence and productivity for families

Performance Outcome: *Increase and then maintain accessibility of child care for served families*

- 5,598 children were served by CCDF subsidies
- 8.6% of potentially eligible families received CCDF subsidies
- 2,930 families were working and/or pursuing training/education with support of CCDF subsidies
