



2026 Training Opportunities for Weighing Evidence and Drawing Conclusions

The Montana Developmental Disabilities Program is offering this free training to DDP Contracted Providers, Targeted Case Managers and DDP staff

The **Weighing Evidence** training provides information regarding how to perform one of the most difficult aspects of conducting an investigation: analyzing the evidence and reaching a conclusion.

Who Should Attend: Targeted Case Managers, and Provider Agency Staff at any level of an organization can attend; however, DDP encourages provider management and staff to attend. DDP staff are also welcome to participate.

What You Need to Know: Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If there is high demand for this training, limits of the number of registrants per organization may be needed. If registering more than one person, please register each person separately.

This online course will be delivered via **Zoom video conferencing** and consists of live lectures and small group exercises. The course materials will be emailed to participants one week before the class. In order to successfully participate, each learner needs a computer/device allowing audio/video interaction. **Class schedule will be 9:00 - 11:30 am & 1:00 - 3:30 pm the first day and 9:00 - 11:30 am on the second day.**
