- 2. Recommendations for next year -
 - Trigger warning for sensitive info, maybe more trafficking info and how we can specifically support people who have been trafficked and are intersecting with our services
 - Peer panel
 - Invite legislators
 - Figure out funding as SOON AS POSSIBLE figure out what the total cost was so we know how much money we need to raise
 - Invite the Governor
 - Change the registration as some people signed in multiple times
 - Survey may have been misinterpreted for the rating system, so assure it is super clear for the next symposium
 - More time for Q&A after the presentations
 - Different dietary options for vegetarians/vegans
 - Ice breaker in the beginning to warm people up to meeting others and getting out of their comfort zone

Update on status of Peer Support Medicaid Policy Revision Recommendations

- Issac Coy the recommendation to have the mental health diagnosis expanded and approve group peer support (max 8 people, \$3.23/person/15 min.) has been approved. Not willing to expand to additional settings at this time.
- Discussed that if we had an actual number of who within the recovery residences
 or drop-in centers have capacity for the clinical oversite piece for peer support
 we could add an actual numbers of locations that may change their decision to
 expand. Tara will contact the certified homes to see if they have the capacity to
 implement the clinical portion required for Peers and report back to Issac.
