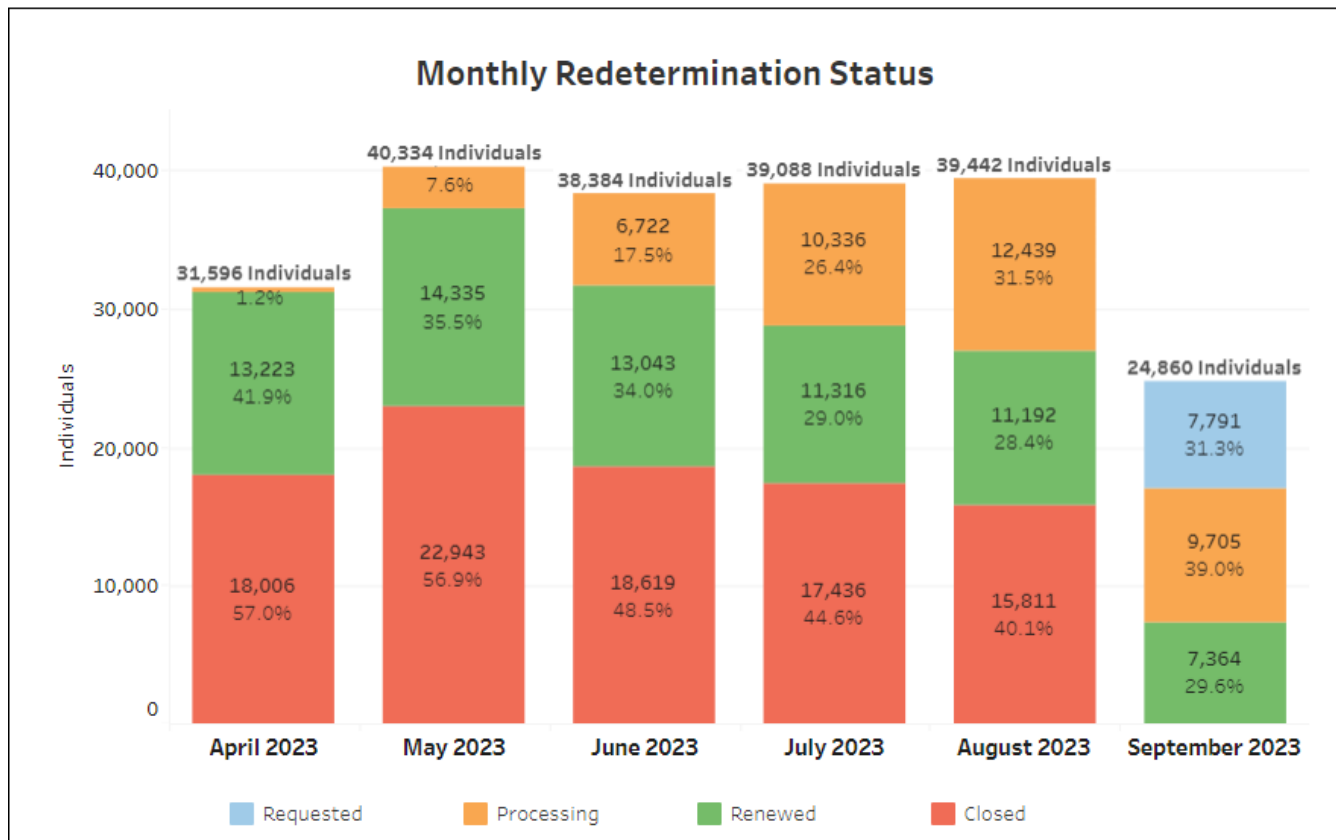




**Medicaid Redetermination Process Updates:**

Medicaid Redeterminations Dashboard:

Cycle: each month represents the month the redeterminations were initiated – for example, 31,596 were initiated in April. These individuals were due for redetermination in May. Coverage would be lost June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Data through closures that happened October 1<sup>st</sup> (initiated August):

Total Initiated: 188,845 (57% of case load)

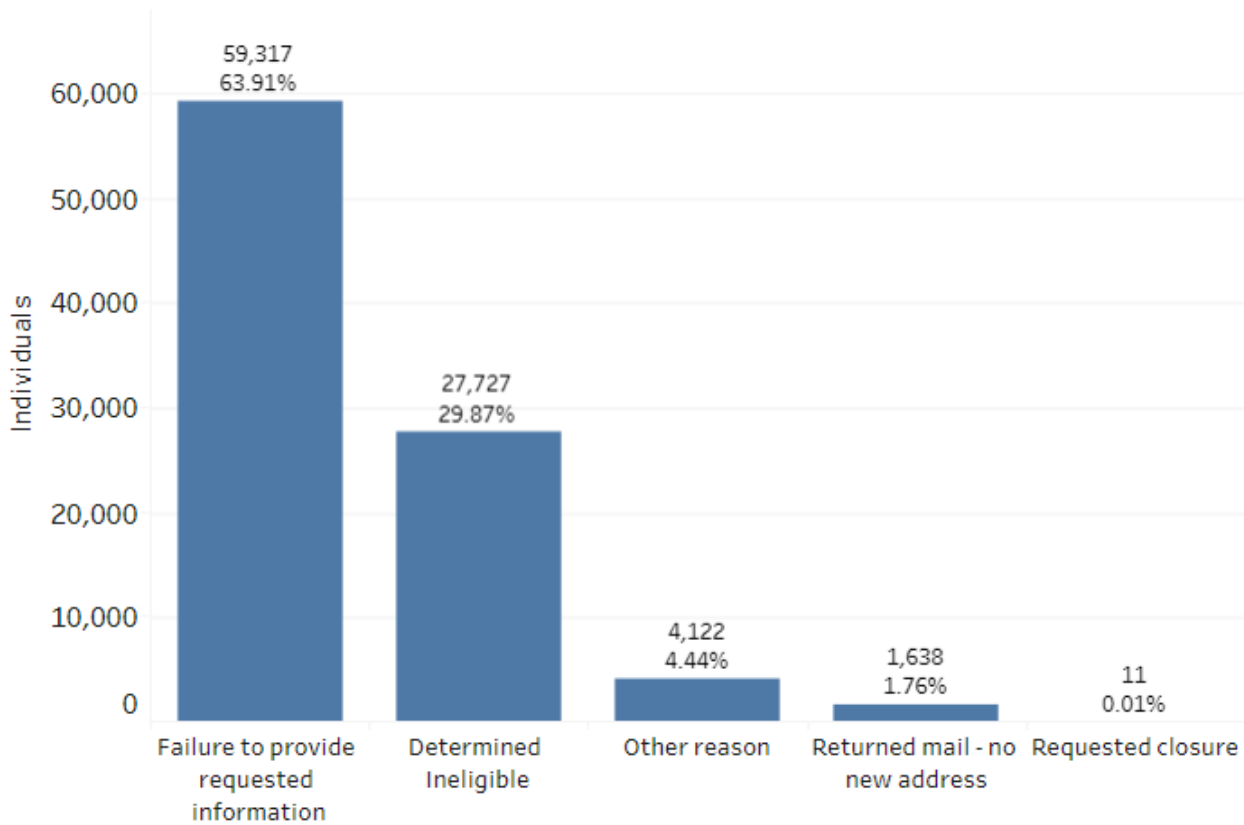
Total Disenrolled: 92,815 (49% of individuals initiated)

Total Renewed: 63,109 (33% of individuals initiated)

Total Pending: 32,920 (17% of individuals initiated)



### Cumulative Closure Reasons



Reasons for closures:

Failure to Provide Requested Information – did not return packet or did not return verifications.

Determined Ineligible: Ex: Over Income, aged out of HMK or adult programs, Transitional Medicaid

For Clients who indicate a Tribal affiliation (through disenrollment September 1):

Total Initiated: 20,649

Total Disenrolled: 9825 (48% of individuals initiated)

Total Renewed: 8826 (43% of individuals initiated)

Total Pending: 1998 (10% of individuals initiated)

#### Communication Changes

- Public Assistance Helpline: new Tier response options
- Mailed Communications: Each Household will get at least 5-7 touchpoints (mail/texts/emails) before a procedural disenrollment.
- Data provided to Indian Health Service: Individuals who have not responded by the “due date” and are at risk of losing coverage.

#### Medicaid Eligibility Changes:

- End of 12 Month Continuous Eligibility
- End of Passive Renewals
