CSAVR 2024 Spring Conference

NET UPDATES

NET and Deaf Professional Network (DPN) session with Sodexo: January 22, 2024. The NET and the DPN are co-hosting an information session with Sodexo. Sodexo is interested in increasing the representation of individuals who are Deaf, HH, D-B and late deafened in their talent pipeline. This session will include internship opportunities. Sodexo has a range of internships in a variety of areas which include management, accounting, HR, finance, operations, management, dieticians/nutritionists, and IT.

The NET and DPN are collaborating with Helen Keller National Center (HKNC) and have also invited university career center staff from: CSUN, Gallaudet and NTID as well as the Director/Liaison in the Office of Special Education and Rehabilitation Services (OSERS) at the U.S. Department of Education that provides federal funding to these specialized programs.

SharePoint – NET Training Session. The CSAVR-NET hosted a training session to introduce the NET SharePoint site. Participates learned how it is organized, how to share information and set up their own account. Thank you to Kevin Red who has been collaborating with us to set up the site and for conducting the training on the organization and technical aspects of the NET SharePoint site. This site will enable NET points of contact and VR Training Center Directors to share information across programs and between states.

The Careers and Business Relations Committee and the NET are collaborating with the Operations and Personnel Committee and the TAC-QE Learning Communities to gather information on the structure and personnel supporting business relations within the VR agencies across the country.
