



Montana SNAP Retailer Compliance Attestation Form

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is making changes to items eligible for purchase with SNAP funds. Implementing these changes may require you to update your existing point-of-sale (POS) system or operational processes to no longer allow these items to be purchased with SNAP funds. In order to expedite this process, the Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) will provide a list of applicable items for the beginning of this process. Retailers will be responsible for updating their systems for additional products in the future.

Starting Nov. 1, 2026, the following categories of items cannot be purchased with SNAP funds:

- Candy
- High-sugar beverages
- Energy drinks
- Shelf-stable prepared desserts

All Montana SNAP retailers must prepare to implement these changes by Nov. 1, 2026. The changes should be implemented by this date **but not sooner**. Please attest below to compliance with these changes.
