



ACA/FAMILY MEDICAID 201-1

ACA Parent/Caretaker Relative (Family Medicaid)

Supersedes: FMA 201-1 (01/01/09)

Reference: 42 CFR 435.110, .602; ARM 37.82.101, .701, .702 & .703; PL 104-193; 42 USC 1396b

Overview: Parents or Caretaker Relatives may qualify for ACA Parent/Caretaker Relative (PCR) Medicaid if they have an eligible child living in their home. An eligible child is a child under age 19 who is within the 5th degree of kinship of the caretaker relative, including children receiving SSI. **NOTE:** If the child's parent is in the home, a caretaker relative cannot receive ACA PCR coverage.

Total countable income is tested against the ACA PCR income standard (ACA FMA 003 Table of Standards- ACA Parent Caretaker Relative Income).

NONFINANCIAL CRITERIA:

Medicaid standard nonfinancial requirements are listed in section CMA 300 Non-Financial Overview. In addition to the standard criteria that applies to all Medicaid programs, the following non-financial criteria are specific to ACA PCR:

- Child must be living with a parent/specified caretaker relative
- Age (must be a dependent child under age 19 within 5th degree of kinship)
