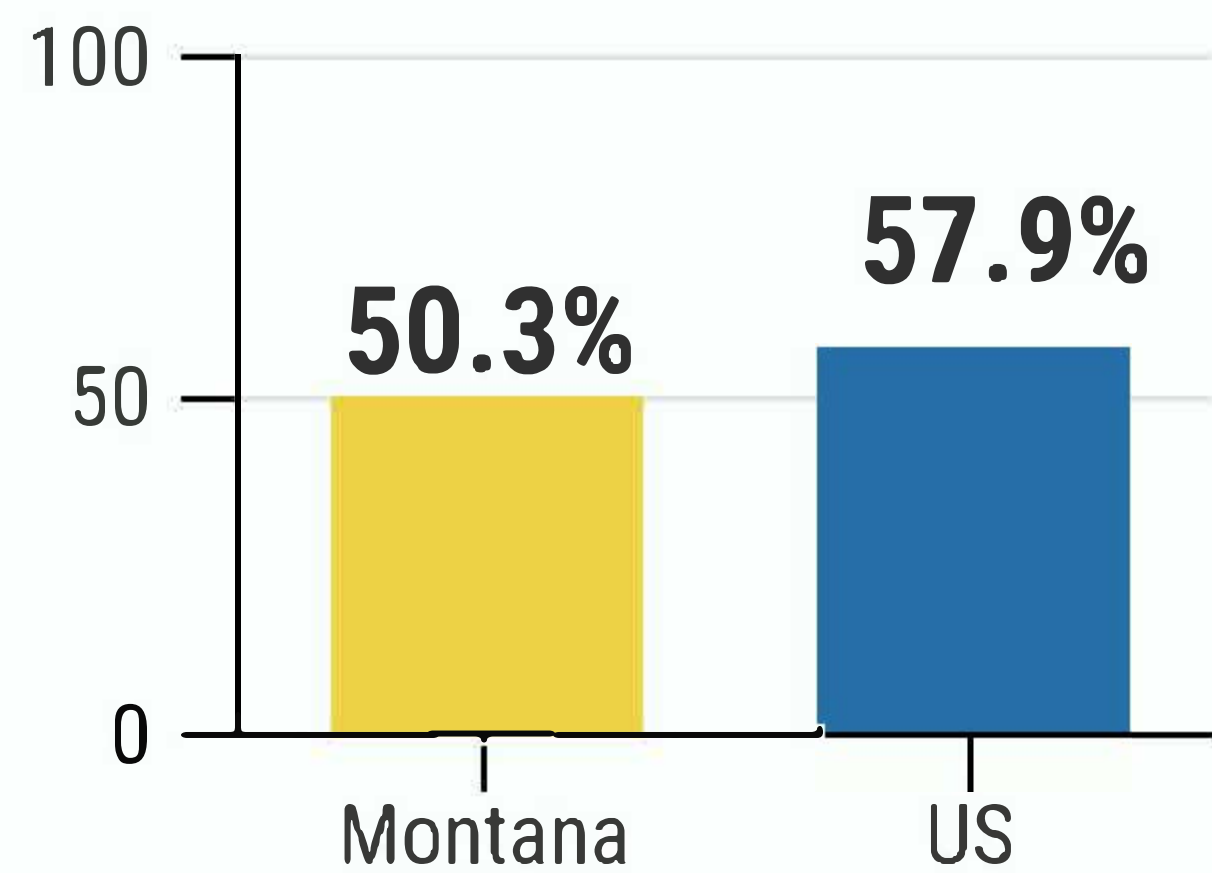


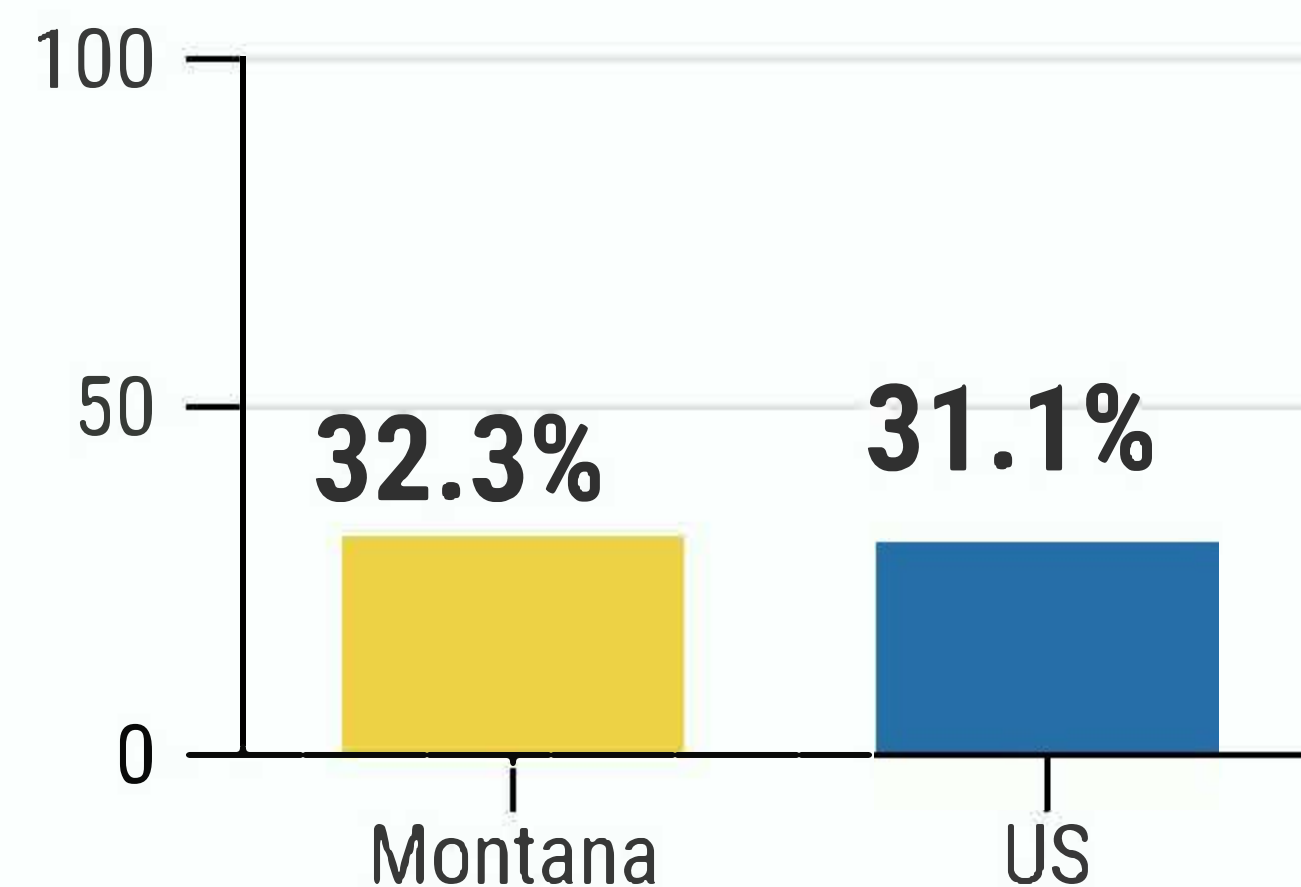

How many Montanans were vaccinated against influenza?

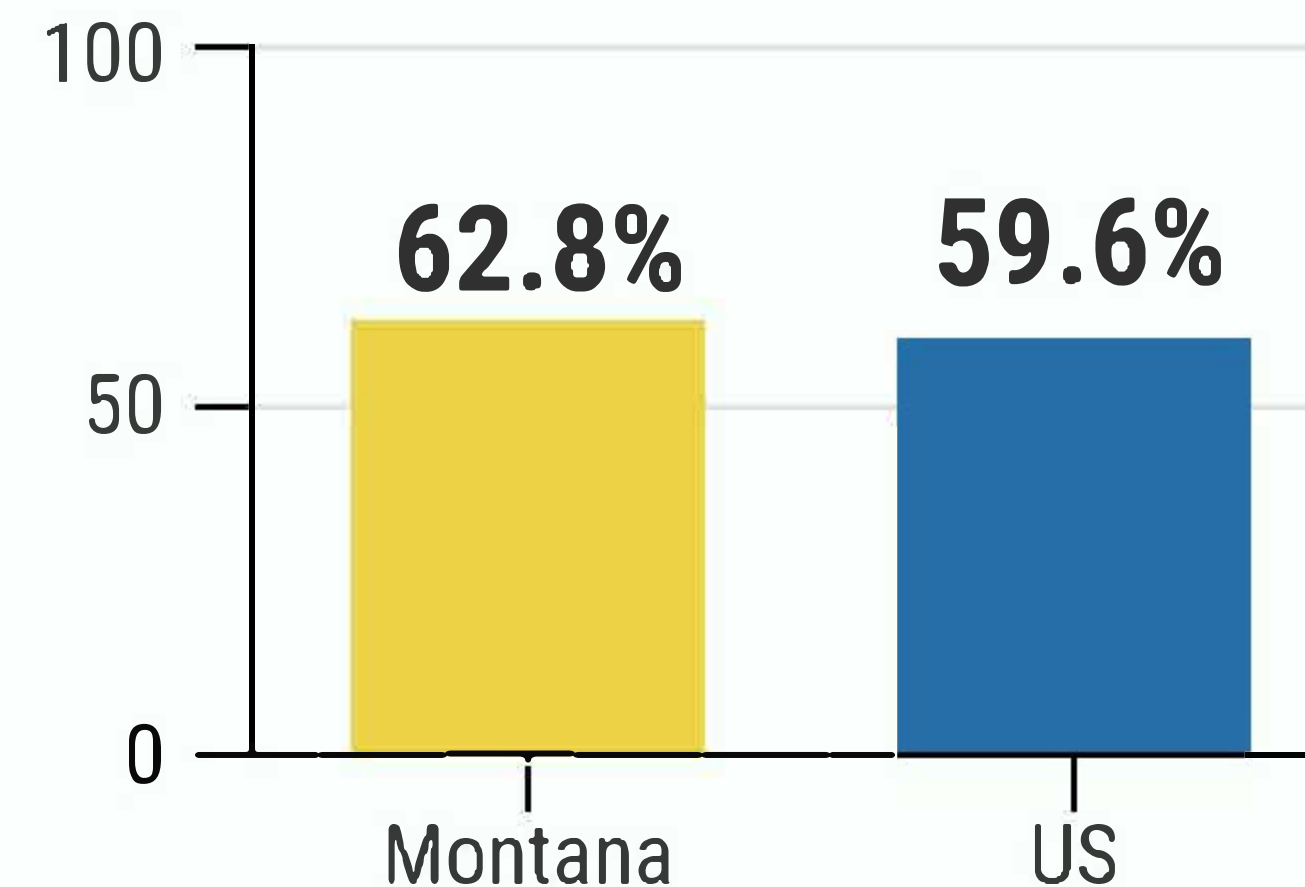
6 months-17 years



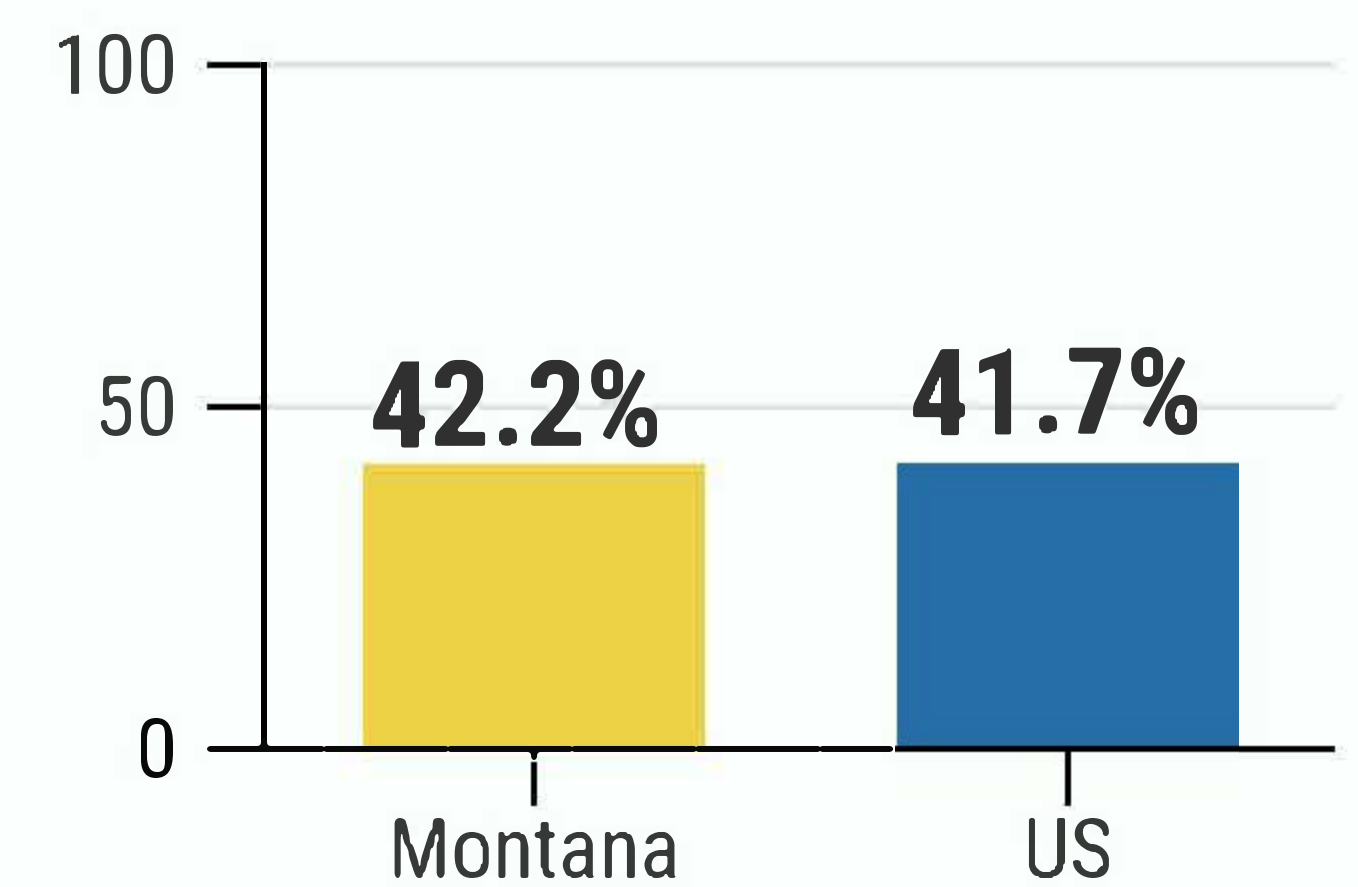
18-64 years



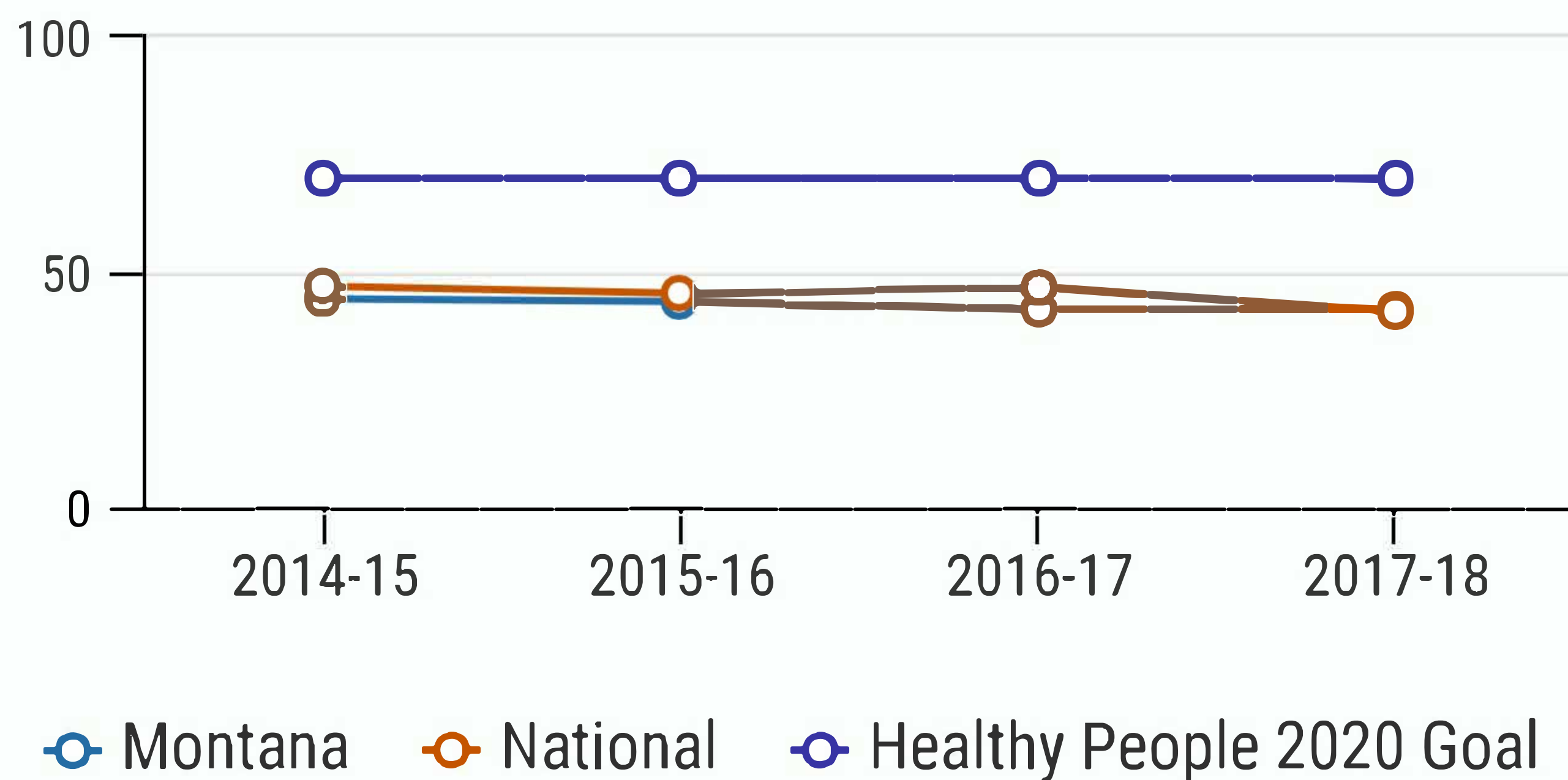
65+ years
