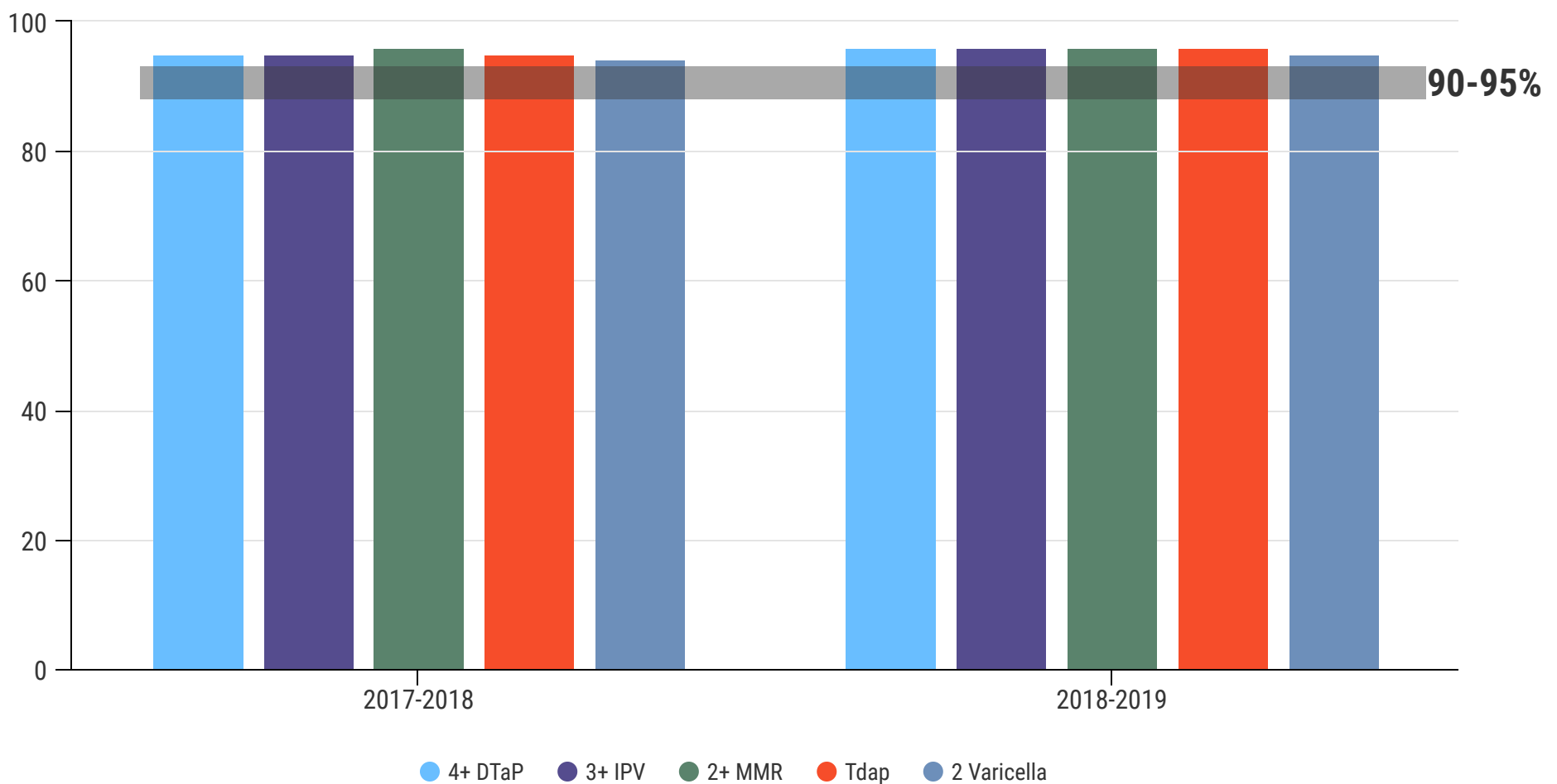
students enrolled in public and private k-12 grades for the '18-'19 school year had either a religious or medical exemption for at least one vaccine

90 to 95% = Herd Immunity

Depending on the disease, if this percentage of the population in an area is vaccinated, **community or herd immunity** will be achieved. This helps limit the spread of the illness and protect those who may not be vaccinated because of age or a medical or religious reason.
