High Priority Census Areas: Is based on a composite score that includes: Tier 1 includes Hypertension (top 20th percentile), 5 or 6 of each co-morbidity (high cholesterol, diabetes, obesity, currently smoke, coronary heart disease, and stroke) that are top 40th percentile, neighborhood deprivation index greater than 0 (for Tier 2, neighborhood deprivation index=0) and Index of Deepest Deprivation.
