
Youth Suicide in Montana



The youth suicide rate in Montana was consistently more than double the national rate 1

Suicide was the #1 cause of preventable death for Montana youth ages 10-14 years³





of Montana's adult firearm owners living with someone under 18 years old had an **unlocked** firearm in their home⁵



Most youth suicide victims didn't show that they were at risk²

Youth (10-17 years) in the **hidden risk group** had minimal contact with mental health or legal systems, fewer documented social problems, and were more likely to use firearms than youth in the visible risk

77% Hidden Risk 23% Visible Risk
