## Asthma FIRSTAID





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## Sit the child upright.

Be calm and reassuring. Do not leave them alone.

## Help the student use an Emergency Rescue Inhaler.

Encourage the child to breath slowly and deeply.

Additional puffs may be needed based on the child's asthma action plan.

\*An emergency or rescue inhaler is a type of inhaler that dispenses medication to relieve or stop the symptoms of an asthma attack. Albuterol is the most commonly used short-acting medication in rescue inhalers.





Wait five minutes.





If there is no improvement, call 911 and have the child take 2 more puffs.
